
Q3 From the list of age bands below, please indicate the category that includes your current age


Q4 What is your Gender?



Q5 Is your gender identity the same as that which you were assigned at birth?






Q7 Are your day-to-day activities limited because of a health problem or disability which has lasted, or is expected to last, at least 12 months?




Q9 Ethnic Group: Asian/Asian British






Q12 Religion or belief: What is your religion or belief?







Q13 Sexual orientation: What is your sexual orientation?





Q14 Socio-economic background: If you went to University (to study a BA, BSc course or higher), were you part of the first generation of your family to do so?





Q15 Did you mainly attend a state or fee paying school between the ages 11-18?




